### What's New in Oracle User Productivity Kit Professional 6.1 and 6.2?

Oracle is pleased to announce Oracle User Productivity Kit (UPK) Professional 6.1. Oracle UPK Professional consists of Oracle UPK 3.5 and the Knowledge Pathways 5.5 modules. With this release Oracle has incorporated a number of enhancements for each component of Oracle User Productivity Kit Professional 6.1.

#### Oracle User Productivity Kit v3.5 New Features

New Feature	Description/Benefit
<b>Customizable Document Output</b>	Organizations can differentiate their documentation by customizing their outputs to meet their business needs. Users are familiar with corporate standards and organizations now have the ability to easily maintain corporate branding standards as well as create new and modify existing outputs for all their project documentation.
<b>Automatic Context Capture in IE-based applications</b>	Previous versions of UPK captured context information during recording sessions for Oracle and SAP applications only, enabling context-sensitive help to reduce ongoing performance support costs. With the addition of the new SmartMatch feature, context information can now be captured for any Internet Explorer browser application as well, enabling context-sensitive help for browser-based applications across the enterprise.
<b>Copy and Paste Frames</b>	The ability to copy and paste frames allows users to re-use content across topics dramatically reducing content creation time.
<b>Print It! Mode</b>	Authors can choose to automatically include printable job aids or system process documents for just-in-time support. This new mode saves time and provides users with easy access to key documentation.
<b>Additional Languages: Finnish, Turkish, Polish, Russian, Hungarian, Traditional Chinese, Korean</b>	Finnish, Turkish, Polish, Russian, Hungarian, Traditional Chinese, Korean have been added to our list of delivered tier 2 languages, which brings the list of delivered languages to 21.
<b>Add Keywords, Roles, and Context to Modules and Sections</b>	Ability to insert non-topic assets, including context, into the Table of Contents expands the types of content available for use. This flexibility enables users to view multiple types of content for enhanced learning.



<b>Library Security</b>	Manage read and write access to folders. With the ability to control access to content across the organization, developers only work on what they've been assigned to. This helps ensure data accuracy and efficiency.
<b>Target Applications Added</b>	Context sensitivity is now offered for Agile and JDE World applications.
<b>Customizable Library Views</b>	Apply filters in the library based on the way users organize their content to analyze data or check project status. Custom views put all the power into the users to view what they want and how they want to meet their business needs.
<b>Auto Recorder</b>	Enables recording without having to provide a cue to capture each action.
<b>Improved Sound Capabilities</b>	Supports compressed mp3 files reducing overall size of files and content. In addition, exporting and importing of sound is much more robust.
<b>Enhancements to Re-record functionality (insert and skip)</b>	Create efficiency by targeting only frames that need to be updated during the re-record process with the ability to insert and skip frames.
<b>Redesigned Player Table of Contents</b>	Sporting a sleek new design, the Table of Contents Player has been modernized to be more visually appealing. Icons have also been enhanced. Play modes are more closely associated with the content, only available modes appear, and the default mode is launched when a topic is selected.
<b>Enhanced Search in the Player</b>	Increase efficiencies by applying any combination of the role filter, applicable filter, and the search feature to define more specific criteria.
<b>Direct Do It!</b>	Direct Do It! immediately launches Do It! mode when only one topic exists reducing the number of clicks to view content. Users don't need to open the Table of Contents first to view the single topic.
<b>HP Quality Center XLS Output</b>	HP Quality Center test scripts are now exported to .xls format.
<b>Enablement Pack – patch support</b>	Incremental updates to UPK are available via smaller packages or “patches” instead of full releases.
<b>Publish by State</b>	In addition to publishing by role, authors can publish an outline or selection by state to track project status.
<b>Firefox 3.0 Support</b>	Support for Firefox 3.0 browser enables expansion of user community and ensures user adoption.
