Arpège-Groupe Caisse d'Épargne Implements Project Management Solution in Six Months

Part of the Savings Bank Group, Arpège-Groupe Caisse d'Épargne (ARPEGE) is one of three IT Consortia (GIE) in France. It manages the information systems of 14 savings banks throughout France.

Challenges

- Recast the management information system (MIS), which had become unsuited for the far-flung structure of the group
- Guarantee that information systems align with corporate goals and that they participate in the global governance of the Savings Bank
- Provide a built-in management tool to offer users unique and reliable information
- Improve financial management
- Enable the integration on of the new MIS with the future HR information system of the Savings Bank Group

Solution

- Worked with Business At Work to implement the solution—built on Oracle’s PeopleSoft Enterprise Service Automation—in six months, covering project management, purchasing management, and financial management
- Provided business critical data to 800 users, including 200 frequent users (accountants, buyers, project heads, managers)
- Allowed the savings bank management to leverage clear reporting to measure GIE business against the overall corporate goals
- Enabled a net optimization of costs by inputting data to a single referential, enhancing the overall running of IT activities
