**e-Learning for Health Turns to Online Learning to Resolve Shortage of Radiologists in United Kingdom**

e-Learning for Health (e-LfH) is the gateway for electronic learning within the United Kingdom’s National Health Service. By incorporating interactive content in a self-paced environment as part of the training for many medical disciplines, e-LfH plans to improve teaching quality and consistency, reduce course length, and increase the number of qualified specialists.

**Challenges**

- Address the United Kingdom’s need for more qualified radiologists without putting additional strain on the current training infrastructure
- Improve training standards, increase efficiency, and cut costs

**Solution**

- Deployed Oracle iLearning to support the Radiology-Integrated Training Initiative (R-ITI), a national program to increase the number of trained radiologists
- Used Oracle iLearning to drive and manage R-ITI’s integrated training system, combining traditional classroom techniques with flexible, interactive, computer-based learning
- Chose Oracle iLearning for its ability to provide the foundations of a complete learning program with automated business flows for managing resources, delivering training, and tracking results for online and classroom-based environments
- Used Oracle iLearning to deliver 850 online sessions, the equivalent to 600 hours of training, very cost-effectively
