## ENAV S.p.A. Improves Control Processes with Unified Enterprise Resource Planning Solution

ENAV S.p.A.’s mission is to improve the safety of air traffic in Italian air space. It provides terminal services—such as approach, take-off, and landing—in 39 airports, and flight path services from four area control centers 24 hours a day. ENAV handles more than 2 million flights a year and an average of 6,000 flights a day. Part of the European air traffic management (ATM) system, ENAV participates in all development, validation in operation, research, and coordination activities.

### Challenges

- Standardize and simplify internal, back-office procedures
- Automate project management processes
- Improve the capitalization of resources in large-scale investments, which totaled US\$1.72 billion between 2004 and 2007
- Improve control of project costs and increase the effectiveness of controls by integrating the organization’s accounting and assets modules
- Review and simplify legacy accounting and purchasing
- Provide stakeholders with standardized and customized reports

### Solution

- Implemented Oracle Projects to integrate disparate legacy systems and provide the organization with a standardized approach to cost control
- Worked with Oracle Consulting to consolidate all departments onto a single enterprise resource planning solution
- Adopted simplified and standardized project management procedures, reducing project managers’ reliance on Excel
- Improved management of interdepartmental communication
- Optimized, reorganized, and simplified financial management and project management tasks
