pack2pack Optimizes Working Capital and International Client Interaction with Centralized IT Platform

pack2pack is a one-stop-shop company for industrial packaging in seven countries. pack2pack collects, reconditions, or recycles industrial packaging, and also produces smaller packaging made of tinplate. The company works with a variety of packaging materials, including steel drums, plastic drums, and intermediate bulk containers (IBCs). pack2pack provides its customers packaging that is both economically and environmentally attractive.

Challenges

- Replace legacy systems with a standardized IT platform for all the group’s sites
- Consolidate all IT operations and support onto a single IT platform
- Allow transparent reporting with a centralized IT environment

Solution
