Challenges

- Update the ministry's database and development tools to provide quicker, more effective and structured services for its citizens
- Train ministry personnel in the new tools and solutions to offer better service, gain stability, and security

Solution

- Implemented Oracle Database for better daily operation procedures at the ministry and to gain flexibility and easy of use
- Implemented Oracle Application Server 10g, bringing greater speed and simplicity in the management and security of applications
- Trained personnel via courses at Oracle University Argentina so they would be able to manage the solution
- Reduced time and complexity of software development up to 60% with Oracle JDeveloper, which resulted in simpler and more sustainable code
