



How to find us



By Rail:

Birmingham International Railway Station, adjacent to the NEC, provides half hourly trains to London Euston (80 minute journey time) and offers excellent services to the rest of the UK.

Solihull, Widney Manor and Dorridge, on the Chiltern Line between London Marylebone and Birmingham. (Chiltern Railways, Virgin Trains)

Shirley, Whitlock's End, Wythall, Earlswood and The Lakes on the Birmingham to Stratford line.

Birmingham New Street on the London Euston to Manchester Line. (Virgin Trains)



By Bus:

The 166 shuttle service operates between the Blythe Valley Park and Solihull Bus station, offering good onward connections to rail and other bus services. Shuttle buses are easily recognised carrying the distinctive house colours of blue on silver and the Blythe Valley logo.



By Air:

Birmingham International Airport is one of the fastest growing airports in the UK, with daily flights to New York and Chicago as well as scheduled flights to most European Cities

SkyRail is a free, fast and convenient way to travel between trains arriving at Birmingham International Train Station and the Airport Passenger Terminal. SkyRail runs about every two minutes with a journey time of less than ninety seconds. Access to BVP from Birmingham International Airport is possible by taking bus 966 to Solihull Station and then bus 166 from the station to BVP. The approximate journey time is 45 to 50 minutes. A good supply of taxis are always available outside the entrance of the Millennium Link Block.
