## **Company Overview**

E2open is a multienterprise supply chain management solution that enables customers to aggregate data, automate processes, and manage performance across the extended supply chain—including internal and external systems, inbound suppliers and logistics providers, and outbound distributors and customers.

## **Integration Overview**

E2open Multi-Enterprise Platform complements Oracle E-Business Suite by providing each trading partner in the supply chain process a holistic 360-degree view of the data from a customer's Oracle E-Business Suite enterprise resource planning (ERP) system.

Oracle E-Business Suite contains the records where customers prepare and maintain their master data and transactional data. E2open receives this data from customers' ERP system and provides access to it for third parties such as suppliers, logistics providers, inventory hub providers, etc. Suppliers have controlled access to their data in E2open and can use the solution to work on their data and communicate back to the customer.

E2open provides visibility and control in the following functional areas:

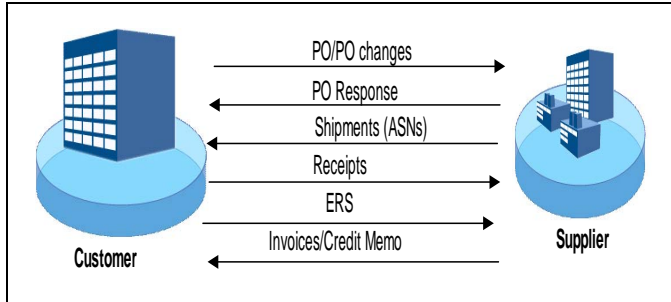
- Order management

E2open integrates with Oracle E-Business Suite for purchase orders and shipments.

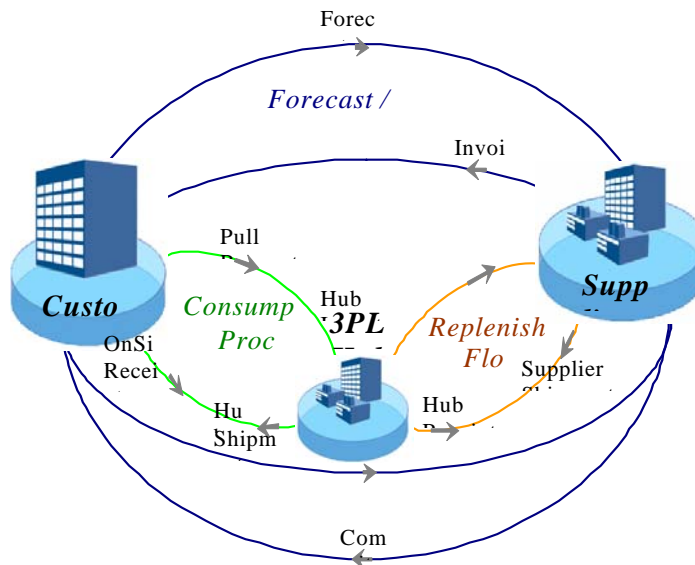

### Inventory Management and Demand Supply Synchronization

This involves integrating with Oracle E-Business Suite for Forecast, Forecast commit inventory on hand and inventory maintained by third-party logistics providers (3PL Hub).

### Integration Areas

Integration is performed in the following order:

1. Data is extracted from Oracle E-Business Suite to E2open
2. Data is received from E2open and written back to Oracle E-Business Suite

The following figure illustrates the data flow between E2open Systems and Oracle E-Business Suite.

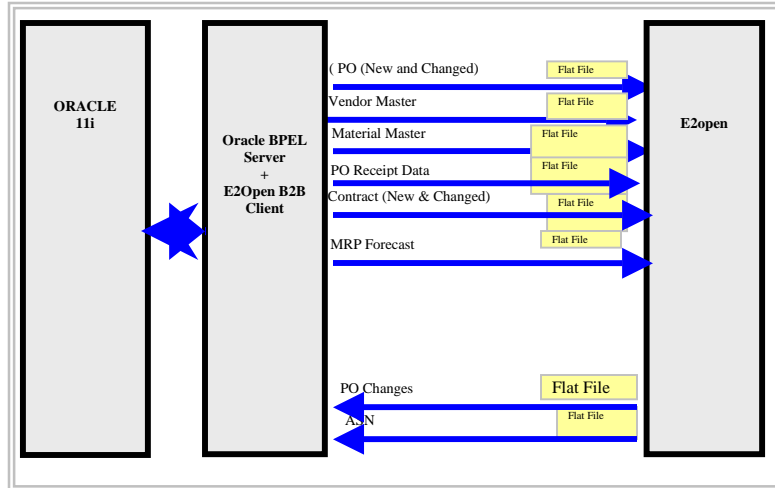
