

IHE Integration Statement Oracle Healthcare Transaction Base

Integrating the Healthcare Enterprise (IHE) is an initiative by healthcare professionals and the health IT industry to improve the way computer systems in healthcare share information. IHE promotes the coordinated use of established standards such as DICOM and HL7 to address specific clinical needs in support of optimal patient care. Systems developed in accordance with IHE communicate with one another better, are easier to implement, and enable care providers to use information more effectively. The IHE Integration Statement below outlines Oracle Healthcare Transaction Base's (HTB) conformance with the IHE Technical Framework and identifies the specific IHE capabilities HTB supports in terms of the key IHE concepts: Actors and Integration Profiles.
