

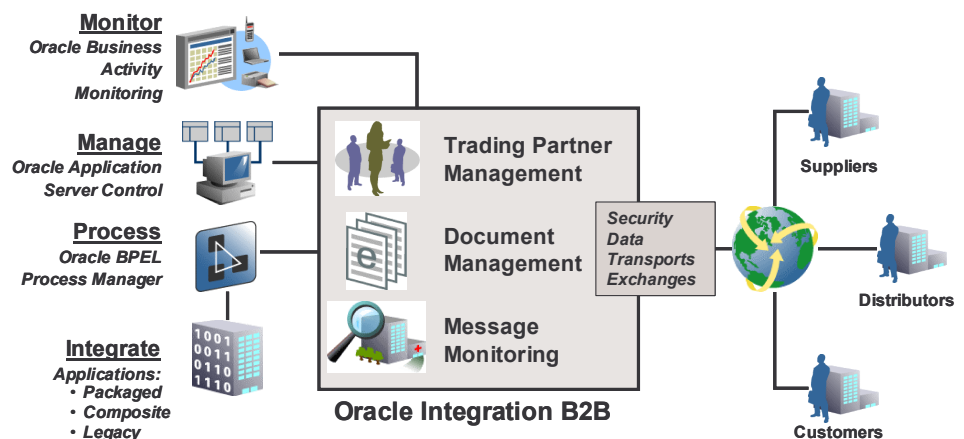

For a company to enable inter-enterprise connectivity requires that it support multiple Business-to-Business (B2B) Standards. Electronic Data Interchange (EDI) is a B2B standard that defines how business information is to be structured i.e. "Purchase Order", "Advance Shipping Notice", "Invoice", ... and exchange, EDI Internet Integration (EDIINT). All information contained in an EDI transaction set is, for the most part, the same as on a conventionally printed document.
