Developer Previews Now Available

Oracle JDeveloper 10g is a world-class development environment for Java, Web services, XML, and SQL. The Oracle JDeveloper 10g (10.1.3) early access release adds many new features, including a new look and feel, a greatly improved coding environment, extensive refactoring options, J2EE 1.4/J2SE 5.0 support, EJB 3.0 support, and visual JSF development.

Oracle Application Server 10g Release 2 (10.1.3) Developer Preview 4, a component of Oracle Fusion Middleware, has passed the J2EE 1.4 compatibility test suite and is officially J2EE 1.4 compatible. Oracle Application Server 10g (10.1.3) Developer Preview 4 is a full release of the application server including Oracle HTTP Server, Oracle Process Manager and Notification, Oracle Containers for J2EE, Oracle Application Server Control, Oracle Business Rules and Oracle TopLink.

Oracle Containers for J2EE 10g (10.1.3) Developer Preview 4 is also provided as a stand-alone download.
