

Oracle 2011 Political Contributions



Dear Stockholder:

Oracle Corporation, our stockholders, and our employees are directly impacted by public policy decisions made in Washington DC, in state capitols in the U.S., and in capitols around the world. Oracle Corporation does business in more than 145 countries, necessitating compliance with a complex web of international laws governing the development and sale of our software and services. Proposed policy changes that impact the amount of taxes Oracle and its employees pay, what countries we can trade with, and the protection of Oracle's intellectual property are just a few of the issues we face around the world. These issues have an important impact on Oracle's bottom line and stockholder value.

A few years ago questions were raised regarding corporate spending on U.S. political activities and the availability of information about political contributions and expenditures. Although Oracle's level of activity in this area is relatively small, we are providing this letter as a level of transparency in addition to what is mandated by the already extensive political disclosure laws governing our activities. This letter and any subsequent updates will be provided to the Finance and Audit Committee of the Oracle Board of Directors and will be available on our Website.

Oracle's public policy agenda is developed and advanced by Oracle's Government Affairs department, which reports to Oracle's president. The company's government relations practices comply with all applicable federal, state, and local laws and disclosure requirements. Oracle's federal lobbying disclosure reports to the Secretary of the U.S. Senate and the Clerk of the U.S. House of Representatives are publicly available at their respective Websites: www.senate.gov/legislative/Public_Disclosure/LDA_reports.htm and http://clerk.house.gov/public_disc. Oracle's political activities in the U.S. are monitored by a full-time Political Compliance Director, reporting under separate lines to Oracle's General Counsel.

As part of Oracle's commitment to improve the public policy environment, Oracle employees came together in 1996 to form our own nonpartisan political action committee, Oracle PAC. Oracle PAC enables eligible Oracle employees and stockholders to support elected officials who share our vision for innovation, competitiveness, regulation, and economic growth. Oracle PAC is a voluntary fund that is separate from Oracle Corporation, and operates in compliance with federal laws governing PAC activities. The PAC is managed by a steering committee that consists of Oracle PAC members and Government Affairs personnel. All Oracle PAC members are welcome to recommend potential recipients of Oracle PAC contributions, and all contributions are approved by the steering committee before disbursements are made. Records of Oracle PAC's Federal Election Commission (FEC) reports, which detail contributions and expenditures, are publicly available on the FEC Website www.fec.gov.
