



Picking Your Path to CCWIS Compliance

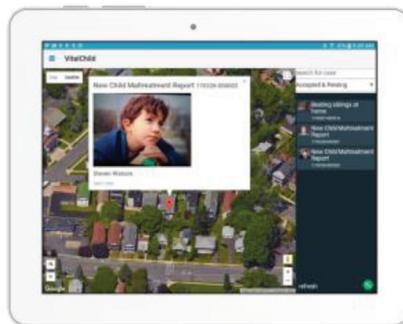
