Common Software Components Support the Complete Product Family

System Foundation is comprised of these software modules:

- Address Book Foundation – central management of all records that manage individuals (employees), vendors, and customers
- EDI Foundation – handles EDI transaction management
- Electronic Mail Foundation – common tools to facilitate e-mail activities
- Order Processing Foundation – handles order processing transactions in concert with modules that process orders
- Self-Service Foundation – core functionality for all JD Edwards EnterpriseOne self-service modules
- Self-Service Order Processing Foundation – integrates order processing transactions with associated self-service functionality
- System Foundation – provides setup and configuration information that is shared among all JD Edwards EnterpriseOne financial management applications
- Work Order Foundation – handles and integrates work order-related transactional activities across the individual products that directly or indirectly access work orders
