The integration between Triple Point's Commodity XL Version 7 platform and Oracle E-Business Suite 12.1 provides customers with a solution for physical commodity management and streamlined workflow supporting the entire lifecycle from requisition to delivery and settlement. More specifically, the integration supports receiving a requisition for trading of a commodity from Oracle E-Business Suite, execution of the requisition through a trade within Commodity XL, Commodity XL sending the consummated trade to Oracle E-Business Suite for creation of the purchase order, Oracle E-Business Suite sending information of the actual commodity received to Commodity XL to update the positions, and Commodity XL sending final pricing information to Oracle E-Business Suite for invoicing and settlement.

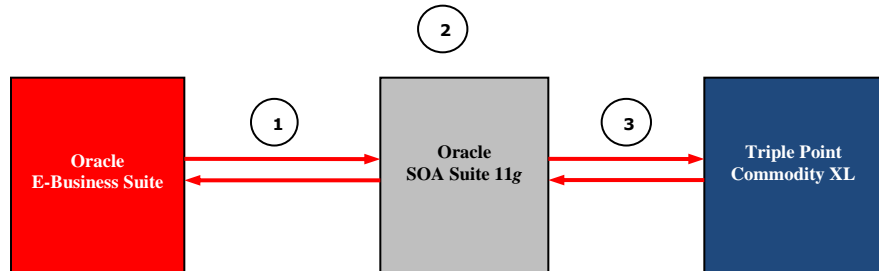

- Trade integration
- Receipts/shipment integration

Integration Functional Overview



1. **Oracle requester/transport provider services** listens for new, approved Oracle requisitions or approved purchase orders from Oracle and invokes Triple Point interface service via Oracle SOA Suite 11g.
2. **Oracle SOA Suite 11g** transforms the appropriate source message to the corresponding target message.
3. **Triple Point requester/transport provider services** listens to new trade created in Commodity XL and invokes appropriate Oracle interface via Oracle SOA Suite 11g.
