



## What's New in Oracle's AutoVue for Agile Enterprise Visualization 20.2.3?

Oracle is pleased to announce the availability of Oracle's AutoVue for Agile Enterprise Visualization 20.2.3, a minor release within the 20.2 product family. With this release Oracle delivers best-in-class support for new formats, and continues to deliver on enterprise readiness enhancements.

<b>New Format Support</b>	AutoVue for Agile 20.2.3 includes support for the following new formats: <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• SolidWorks 2014</li><li>• Solid Edge ST6</li><li>• Altium Designer 10</li><li>• Adobe Acrobat XI (11)</li></ul> Support for the latest versions of CAD files enables companies to take advantage of the latest functionalities of these new versions.
<b>New Platform Support</b>	In this release client support and server platform support has been extended to new platforms: <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Java SE 8 and higher Java Virtual Machine (JVM)</li><li>• Windows Server 2012</li></ul>
<b>Performance improvements in Agile 9.3.4</b>	The following Performance improvements have been made: <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• The file loading performance has been substantially improved in situations where users' files are stored on a DFM different from the one they are using. The file loading performance should speed up.</li><li>• It is now possible to separately control the generation of thumbnails and streaming files when EC is used to check files into</li></ul>

This improvement allows EC customers who want to use thumbnails generated by EC to still benefit from the performance advantages of having streaming files pre-generated.</p> <p>Note: upgrading to the new version of Agile 9.3.4 is required to see these benefits, upgrading AutoVue for Agile alone will not be sufficient.</p>
<p><b>PDF Improvements for Package &amp; Label Management Workflows</b></p>	<p>The following PDF improvements have been made:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- <b>Substantially faster rendering for complex PDF files</b> : Files that include complex gradient fills will see a substantial increase in rendering performance with AutoVue for Agile 20.2.3</li> <li>- <b>Support for Overprinting Fills</b>: This is a feature in PDF and Adobe Illustrator that allows the creation of very specific effects when printing the resulting document. AutoVue for Agile 20.2.3 adds support for this feature, allowing users to easily complete their reviews of documents that contain overprinting.</li> </ul>
<p><b>Usability Improvements</b></p>	<p>AutoVue for Agile 20.2.3 includes the following usability improvements, which aim at making users' work smoother:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Resizing the AutoVue for Agile window when an image in the workspace has been zoom fitted (Horizontal, Vertical or Both) results in the proportional resizing of the image</li> <li>• The AutoVue for Agile applet/window title bar displays the document filename followed by the AutoVue window name: &lt;filename&gt; - AutoVue &lt;Main Secondary&gt; Window</li> </ul>
<p><b>Security Improvements:</b></p>	<p>The following security improvements have been made:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• AutoVue for Agile client components (jvue.jar, jogl.jar and gluegen-rt.jar) include the Trusted-Library manifest attribute to satisfy the changes made in</li> </ul>
