Additional Enhancements in this Release

- **Business Interfaces for Oracle Talent Cloud (Taleo)** supports interoperability between [JD Edwards EnterpriseOne Human Resources](#) and Oracle's Taleo Cloud Service. The interfaces include HR Requisition data and HR Employee Master data.
- **Wine on Premises Operations Reporting** generates the summary of daily records that a winery is responsible to keep, enabling The Alcohol and Tobacco Tax and Trade Bureau to verify the accuracy of on-premise inventory. This report processes daily records for Material and Operation types from the JD Edwards EnterpriseOne Blend and Inventory systems for the winery to prepare tax returns and monthly reports.
- **Business Services Integration (BSSV)** for JD Edwards EnterpriseOne previously standardized on JAX-RPC (Java API for XML-based RPC) to build Business Service


Java code into Web Service artifacts. A replacement standard, JAX-WS (Java API for XML Web Services), is now available. JAX-RPC will be retired beginning with the Java 7 Release. With EnterpriseOne Release 9.2, JD Edwards integrations using JAX-RPC will require modifications to legacy customizations to adapt to new JAX-WS standard.
