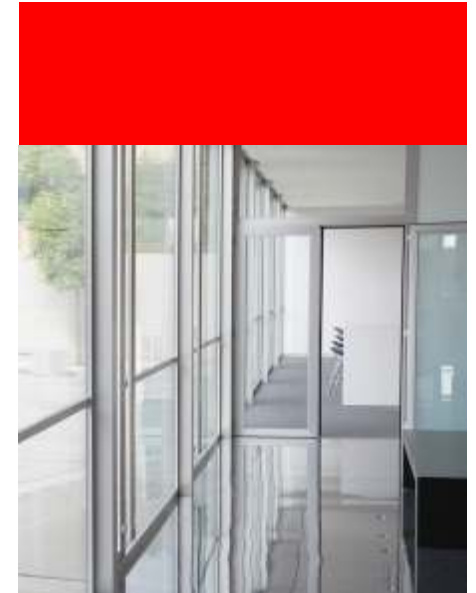

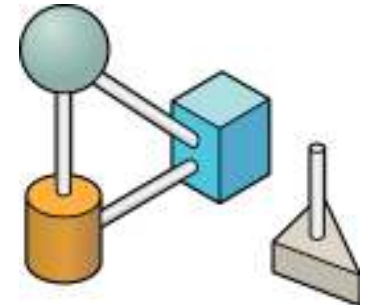

What Exactly *IS* Related Content?

What are the Benefits?

- Mash-up PeopleSoft transactions with collaborative, analytical, and informational content (PS/non-PS)
- Easy to deploy. SME configurable. No/minimal IT involvement. Can eliminate most customizations
- Related content services can execute in the CONTEXT of transactional data
- Open Framework—Customers can develop their own services
- Fully interactive--Not read-only
- Secure: uses the same PS security as the application transaction

- Discussion forums (Interaction with colleagues in context)
- Tagging (public and private)
 - supports end user community categorization of information and provides more robust navigation and search
- Related Links (Associate informational resources to transaction)
- Collaborative Workspaces (full suite of collaborative capabilities)

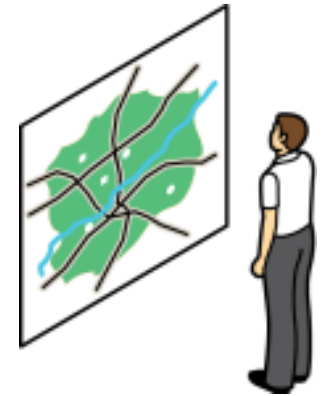

Related Content Framework Tips

- Use redirection iScripts for partial query strings:
 - iScript prepares URL for target and redirects to target
 - Examples:
 - Joining address fields for a map
 - Creating a UCM search string

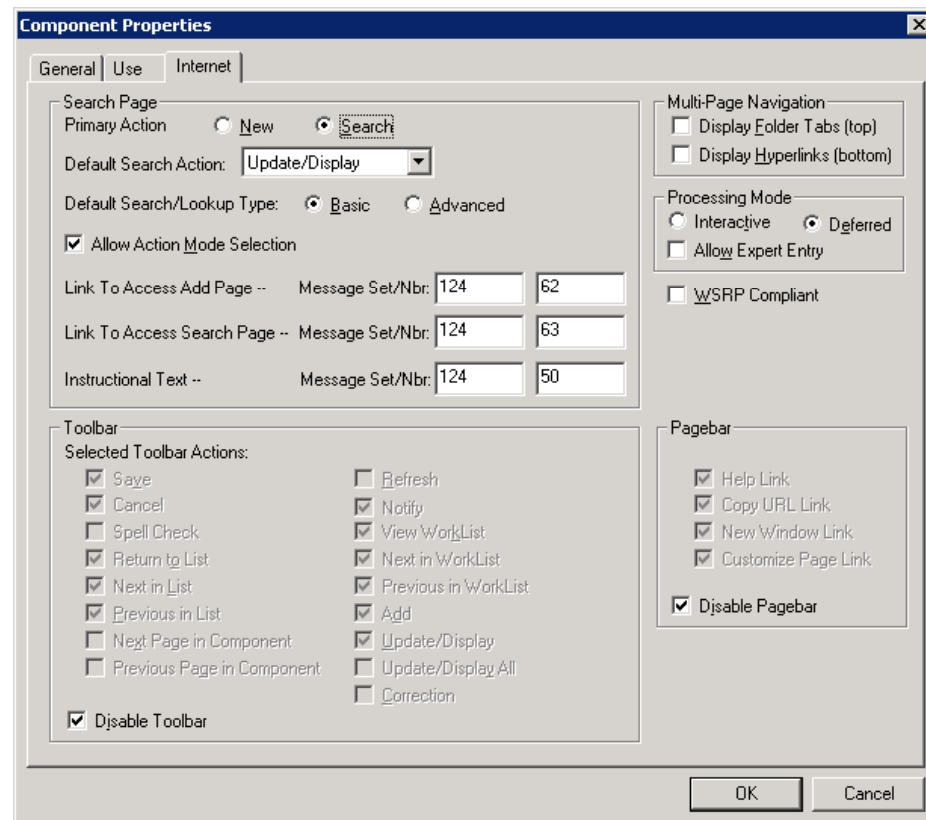

Components

- For RCF components, disable “Internet” features on component:

- Pagebar
- Toolbar
- Folder tabs
- Hyperlinks



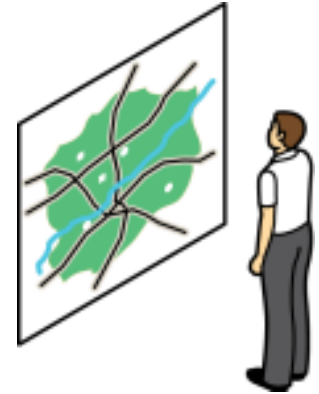


Client-side Mashups

Security Considerations

- Related Content Mashup?
 - Isolation – browser security protects against cross-site scripting
- JavaScript Mashup?
 - Using `<script>` tag that sources external content?
 - Gives external site complete access to your page content
 - NOT SAFE!!
 - Using `` tag that sources external content?
 - Uses browser security settings
 - Can create and read cookies, but can't access cookies across domain
 - Can't access page content

Where Are We Going?

New in PeopleTools 8.51

- **Related Content Improvements**
 - Support for Level 1, 2 and Hidden Fields
 - Contextual popup menus at the field level to access related content
 - Related actions configured via the Related Content framework

Also integrated with improvements to navigation

- **Smart Navigation uses related actions**
 - Drop down menu
 - Org Chart

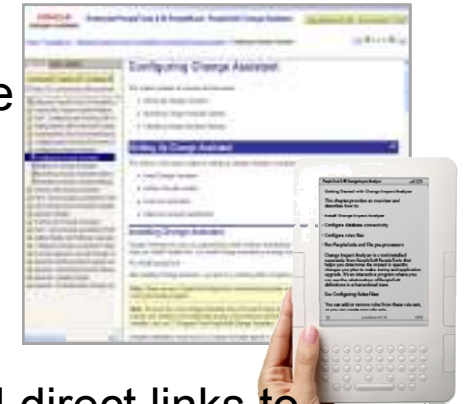

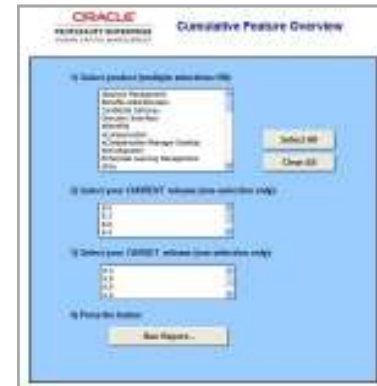
