


## What is the Business Problem?

- Some industries have unique requirements that cannot be addressed by JD Edwards EnterpriseOne configuration options or base functionality
- For instance, suppliers to the food service industry including the restaurant industry routinely sell the same products to repeat customers, often on a daily basis.
- As a result, suppliers have high-volume order entries. Similarly, high-volume order entries are also generated through tele-sales

## The Solution-Order Guides

- Order Guides is a fully functional enhancement that offers a user friendly alternative to the standard order templates application
- The enhancement enables sales personnel to more quickly create orders for regular customers and frequently ordered items
- This enhancement is designed to be "minimally intrusive", and requires no modifications to the base Sales Order Entry (P42101) application, or any of the underlying Sales Order Entry applications

### **Order Guides-Features**



The enhancement enables sales personnel to create orders more quickly for regular customers and frequently ordered items.



You can create templates of items by customer and associate customers with CSR. This association provides easy access to information during sales order entry.



You can view a customer's credit and order details. Additionally, when an order is <u>updated</u>, the system recalculates the order total and available credit amounts.

### **Order Guides-Features**



The system automatically update the Quantity Ordered field for each item in the detail area with predetermined values by clicking the Usual Quantities button.




You can view items that were ordered by a customer during a previous time frame, for example, in the last 30 days




You can view and update the price and profit margin for each line in the detail area
