



What is Oracle APEX Workflow?

Oracle APEX Workflow allows developers to design, implement and automate business process, in whole or part, during which documents, information or tasks are passed from one participant to another for action, according to a set of procedural rules (e.g. sequence flow, transition conditions etc.)



Workflow Lifecycle



In Development

- Fully Editable
- Can only run in developer session
- Can be promoted to active
- Used for testing & updates
- Cannot be deleted



Active

- Partially Editable
- Can be used in production
- Cannot be moved back to development
- Used for live workflow execution
- Cannot be deleted



Inactive

- Not Editable
- Cannot start new instances
- Cannot be made Active or In Development
- Existing instances continue, but no new ones can start
- Can be deleted along with instances







Understanding Human Tasks

Human Tasks in APEX are items that need to be actioned by people, rather than activities performed by a script or automation.



Approval Task


Tasks that can be approved or rejected.

Unified Task Lists

The Unified Task List allows users to view, action, or edit task instances. When you configure the Unified Task List, you have different **Report Contexts** to choose from



Invoke Workflow Activity


The Invoke Workflow activity allows one workflow to call another, enabling modular and reusable process automation.

- Improves Process Efficiency
 - Automates complex workflows by breaking them into smaller, manageable workflows.
- Enhances Reusability

Common processes (e.g., approvals) can be reused across multiple workflows.

Ensures Scalability

Supports dynamic workflow execution based on business logic.



Workflow Connections

Workflow Connections link workflow activities and determine the path through the workflow at runtime.

Types of Workflow Connection



Created by switch activities to split the flow based on conditions.

Transitions

- Normal
- Timeout
- Error



Workflow Participants

Workflow Participants are APEX users with operational privileges over a workflow.

Push notifications in APEX Workflow provide **real-time alerts** to users about workflow events, such as task assignments, approvals, and status updates.





Suspended Workflows


Suspended workflows allow administrators to pause execution, modify variables like amount, and resume without restarting the process.






Resume workflows from any activity


This feature allows a workflow to restart from a different activity than the original failed or stopped point.















Workflow Console Page

The Workflow Console enables users to view and manage their workflow instances. You can configure different Report Contexts based on user roles:





Summary

Process Automation:

Automate end-to-end business processes with visual workflows.

Why Workflow?

Reduces manual intervention, enforces business rules, and improves efficiency.

Workflow Participants:

Involves both system logic and human interactions for tasks and approvals.

Human Task Support:

Assigns, tracks, and manages user tasks with deadlines and outcomes.

Workflow Connections:

Defines execution paths using branches (conditional logic) and transitions (normal, timeout, error).

Editing Suspended Workflows:

Pause and modify workflows mid-execution (e.g., update variables) without restarting.

Custom Activities:

Extend functionality using custom plug-ins for specialized workflow steps.

Workflow Administration:

Use the Workflow Console to monitor and manage instances, and the Dashboard Page to get quick insights into workflow performance


