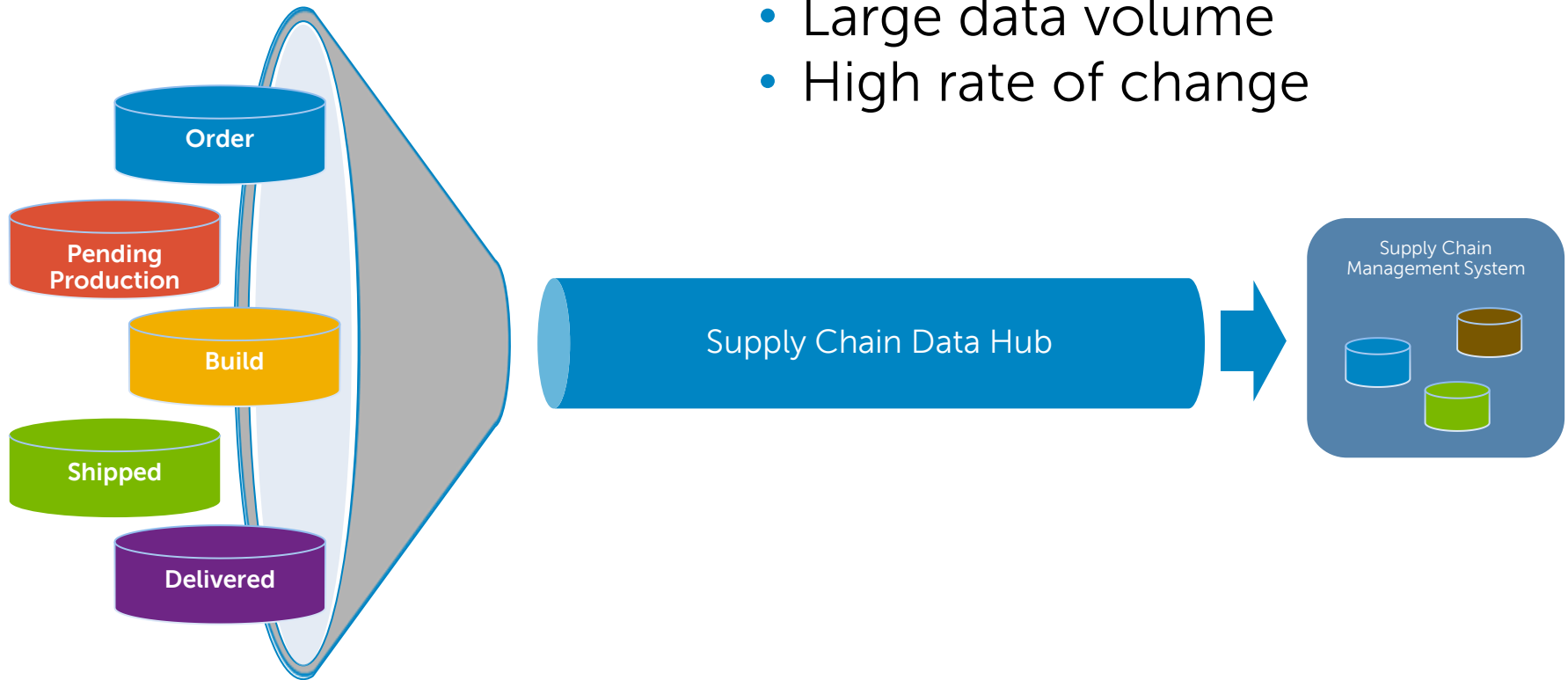

- Response times within seconds



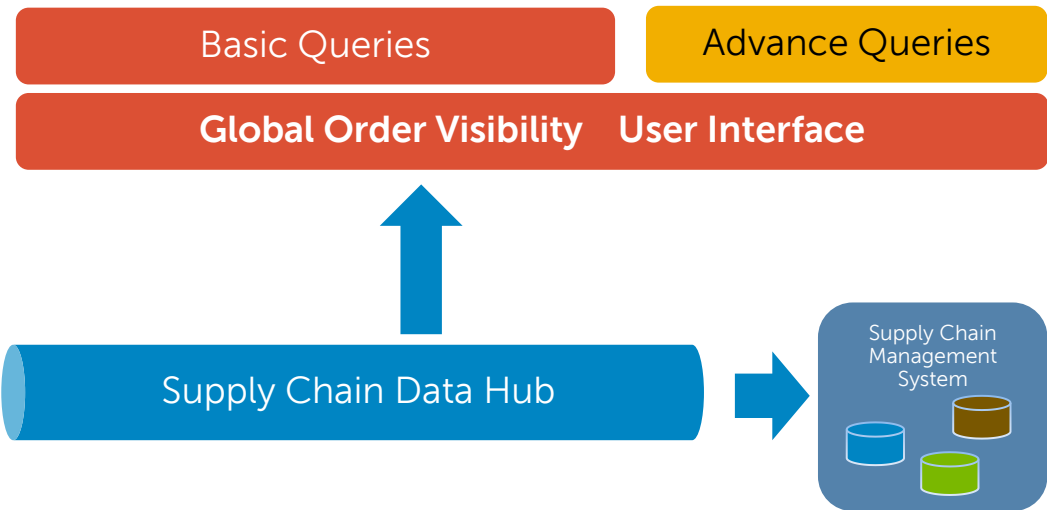
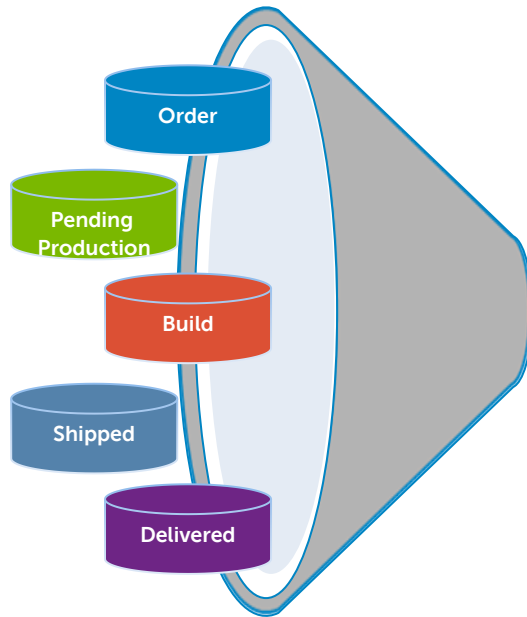

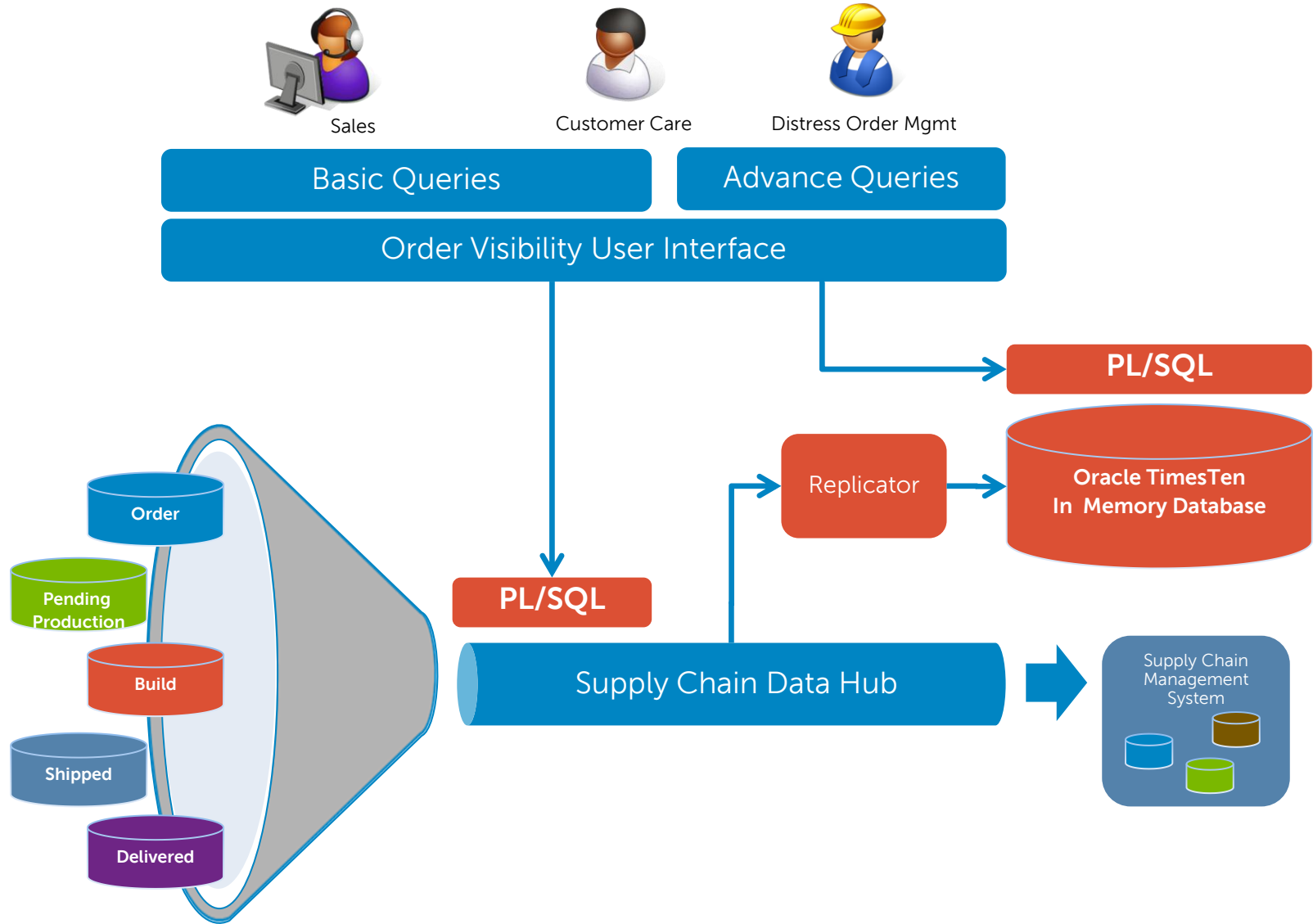

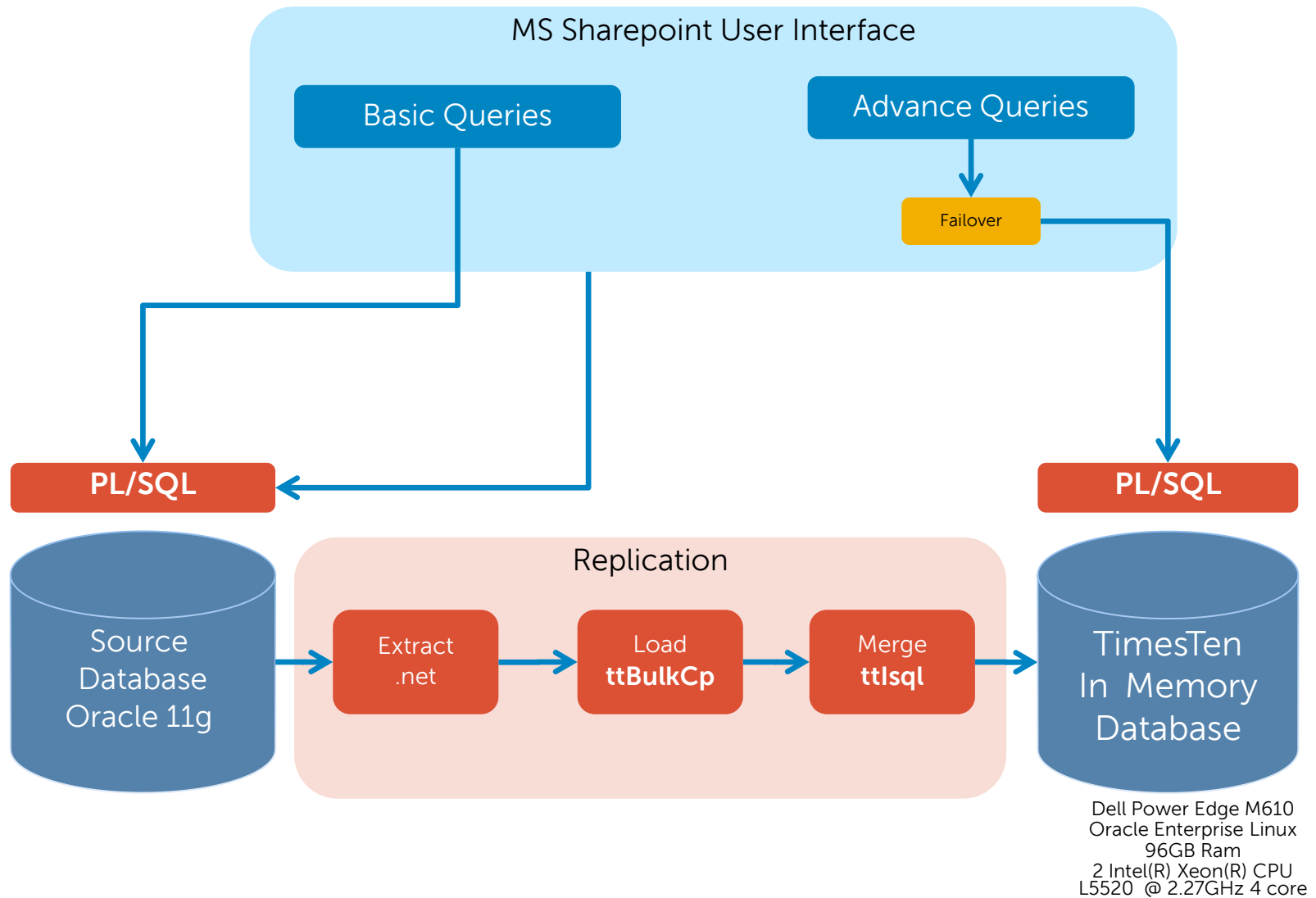
TimesTen Solution Architecture



TimesTen Architecture



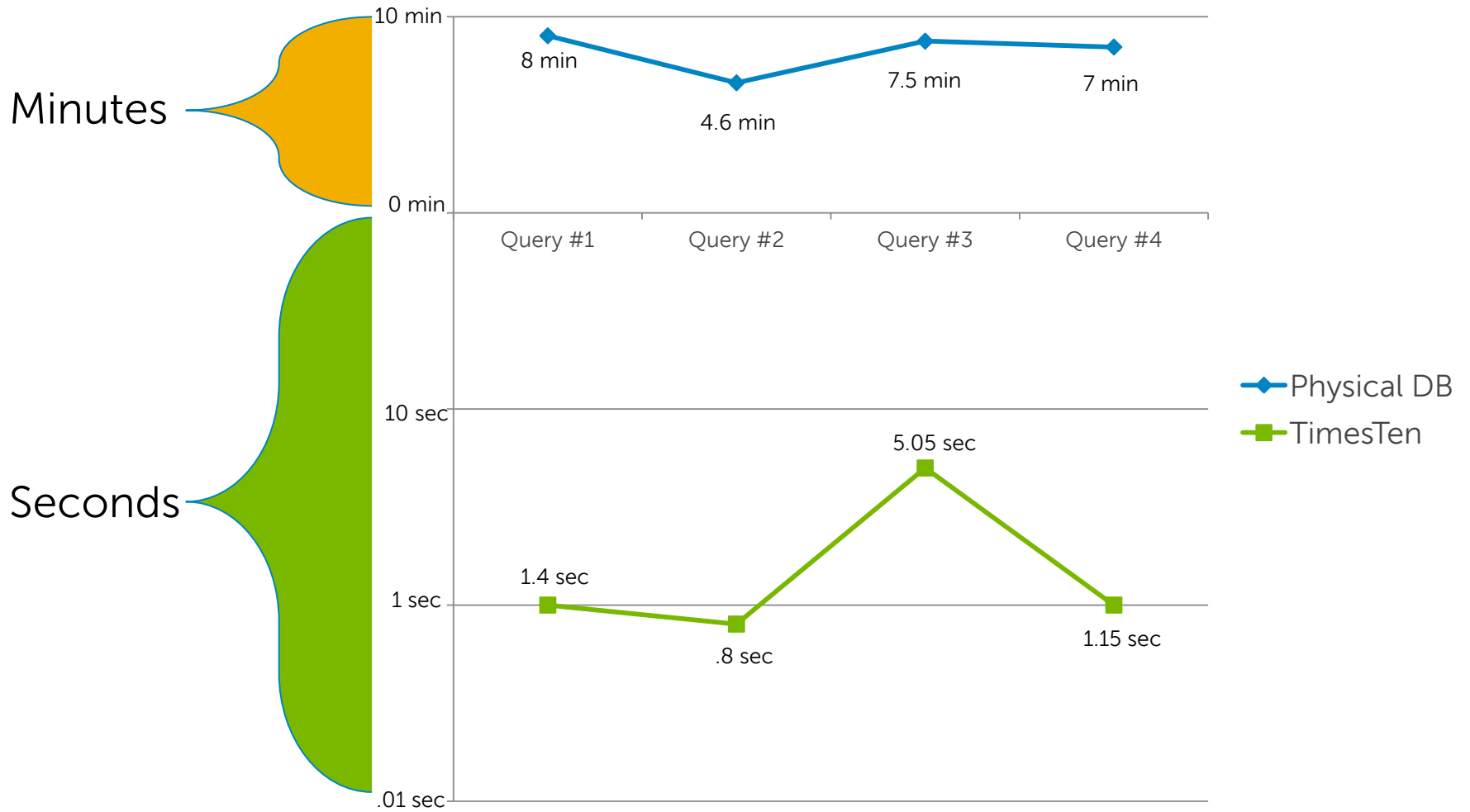
TimesTen Architecture Detail



Performance Statistics

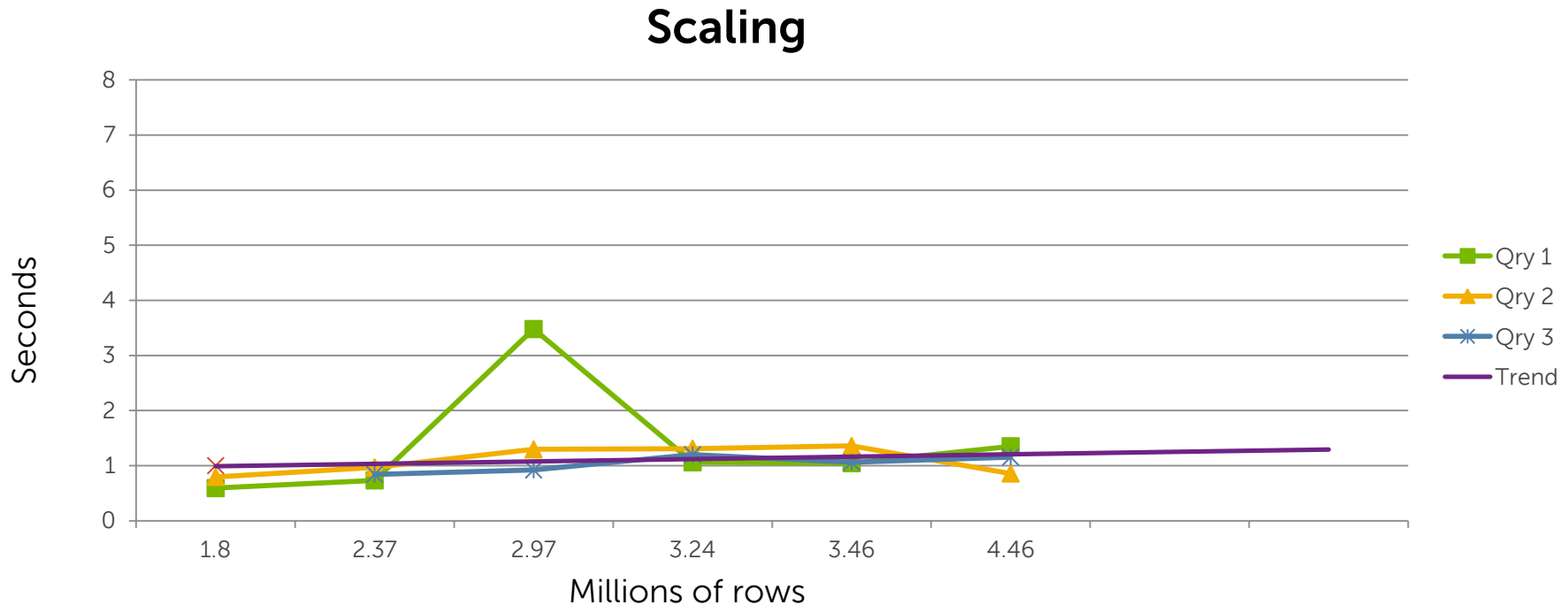


Improved Query Performance



Lessons Learned

- Adding more data doesn't affect performance
- Use sql query to monitor memory usage
 - `select temp_allocated_size, temp_in_use_size, temp_in_use_high_water from monitor;`
- Check high water marks: `temp_in_use_high_water`



Summary

Why TimesTen?

✓ **Transparency**

- Users get increased performance without change in user interface

✓ **PL/SQL**

- Maintain an identical API between our physical and in-memory database
- Developers do not have to learn a new language

✓ **Response Time**

- Significant increase in performance
