“Advanced Customer Support” or “ACS” means a subscription offering that provides You with hands-on product guidance, configuration, support, and ongoing optimization for the Cloud Services.

“Advanced Partner Support” or “APS” means a subscription offering made available to NetSuite partners that provides NetSuite partners with functional and technical assistance to assist Partners in providing support to end customers.

“Bring Your Own Large Language Model” or “BYO LLM” means a large language model provided by You that is compatible with the NetSuite AI Connector Service.

“Extended Hours” means hours in excess of the hours provided as part of the applicable service descriptions.

“NetSuite Onboarding Support Services” means a series of activities and exercises designed to help customers improve their understanding of specific Cloud Services. NetSuite Onboarding Support Services includes but is not limited to: step-by-step exercises, customer-driven walkthroughs, and additional structured check-ins by the ACS team.

“Search Engine Optimization” or “SEO” means the process of improving the quality and quantity of website traffic to a website or a web page from search engines.

“User Acceptance Testing” means testing conducted by the User to determine if the requirements of a specification are met.

1. Description of NetSuite Onboarding Support Services

Oracle will provide up to eighteen (18) hours of NetSuite Onboarding Support Services. The NetSuite Onboarding Support Service hours must be consumed by You within twelve (12) months of the purchase of the following Cloud Services, but in no event beyond the Term of Your Estimate/Order Form:

- A. Oracle NetSuite Planning and Budgeting.
- B. Oracle NetSuite SuiteSuccess for Commerce.

2. Your Obligations and Assumptions

You acknowledge that Your timely provision of and access to assistance, cooperation, complete and accurate information and data from Your officers, agents, and employees (collectively, “cooperation”) are essential to the performance of any Services as set forth in Your Estimate/Order Form. Oracle will not be responsible for any deficiency in performing NetSuite Onboarding Support Services if such deficiency results from Your failure to provide full cooperation.

You acknowledge that Oracle’s ability to perform the NetSuite Onboarding Support Services depends upon Your fulfillment of the following obligations and the following project assumptions:

A. Your Obligations

1. Obtain Cloud Services prior to the commencement of NetSuite Onboarding Support Services under Your Estimate/Order Form and maintain such Cloud Services and for the duration of the NetSuite Onboarding Support Services provided under Your applicable Estimate/Order Form.
2. Provide any notices, and obtain any consents, required for Oracle to perform NetSuite Onboarding Support Services.
3. Do not film or record Oracle’s delivery of the NetSuite Onboarding Support Services, Oracle resources, or any Oracle materials. You may request sessions be recorded by Oracle on a case-by-case basis, such recordings require advanced approval by Oracle.

B. Project Assumptions

1. This Service is not available if ACS offerings are purchased.
2. The Oracle Consultant will not directly access Your Oracle NetSuite instance(s).
3. All project documentation, presentations and project communications are in English, or such other available languages the parties may agree upon in writing.
4. You do not require consultants to work outside standard local country workday hours.
5. Oracle resources are not dedicated to any single project and are engaged across many projects for various customers; Oracle resource assignment is at Oracle's sole discretion.
6. All NetSuite Onboarding Support Services will be performed remotely.

ACS SERVICES

The ACS Service Description below applies to the following items:

1. Supported Products

- A. ACS Services may not be applicable to all Cloud Services. A list of Cloud Services that ACS supports is available upon request.

2. ACS Review

- A. In addition to the ACS Services described in Section C below, Oracle will perform an ACS Review of Your Oracle NetSuite instance(s). Oracle will conduct the ACS Review in accordance with the following schedule: (a) with regard to ACS Monitor, Oracle will commence the initial ACS Review within one month of the signature date of Your Estimate/Order Form; (b) with regard to ACS Optimize and ACS Architect, Oracle will commence the initial ACS Review within three months of the signature date of Your Estimate/Order Form. Each ACS Review conducted during the Term will not exceed the number of Assigned Review Hours for the associated ACS Service set forth in the table below.

- B. Oracle will perform an ACS Review every twelve months during the Term of Your Estimate/Order Form (the “ACS Review Period”). The Assigned Review Hours will be reset on the Start Date indicated in Your order and each anniversary of the Start Date thereafter. For avoidance of doubt, if the initial Term is less than twelve months, You are entitled to such aforementioned ACS Review.
- C. ACS Review hours can only be used for requirements, gap and performance analysis, systems inventory, requirements traceability matrix and/or solution. During the Term of Your Estimate/Order Form, Oracle will provide You with up to the quantity of ACS hours per month specified in Your Estimate/Order Form for any of the ACS offerings related to Your Cloud Services set forth in this Oracle NetSuite ACS Service Descriptions document.

- D. Oracle will determine in its sole discretion the number of hours necessary to perform each ACS Review. If an ACS Review requires more than the number of ACS Review hours set in the Term of Your Estimate/Order Form, then those ACS Review hours will be reallocated from ACS hours and or can be purchased via Extended Service packs or Extended Hours.
- E. If the number of ACS Review hours required to complete the ACS Review is less than number of ACS Review hours set in the Term of Your Estimate/Order Form, then the unused ACS Review hours are automatically forfeited and do not entitle You to any refund, or any credit toward additional or other services.

3. ACS Hours (unless otherwise specified, applicable to all ACS offerings described herein)

- A. If any individual request from You for any ACS offerings set out above exceeds an estimated duration (as determined solely by Oracle) of hours specified in Your Estimate/Order Form, such individual request shall not be considered eligible for delivery by Oracle under Your Estimate/Order Form.
- B. Provide guidance and/or assist with execution of development activities.
- C. Provide guidance and/or assist with execution with application configuration.
- D. Provide awareness of upcoming releases.
- E. Discuss possible impacts to Your Oracle NetSuite instance.
- F. Provide guidance on new or enhanced features that You can leverage in Your Oracle NetSuite instance.
- G. Test existing process of Your Oracle NetSuite instance against the new releases as requested by You.
- H. Review and provide guidance for the requirements, design and configuration, and technical components.
- I. Create website analysis reports reflecting a rolling cumulative analysis of KPIs.
- J. Create reports containing data, system design, configuration and performance risks in Your Oracle NetSuite instance(s). Such reports will highlight analysis, insights and recommendations on area of improvement.
- K. Create, configure and deploy fixes related to customizations and alternate solutions for core product issues and limitations.
- L. Create and deploy code for customizations and integrations to meet business requirements as request by You.
- M. Assist and/or perform product testing that includes but is not limited to unit testing.
- N. Configure or modify the connection of specified BYO LLM with Your existing Oracle NetSuite instance.
- O. Perform prompt engineering, including creating artificial intelligence prompts (“AI prompts”) and providing guidance on the creation of an AI prompt library, and provide the following assistance as agreed upon:
 - 1. Work with You to create AI prompts that route to a recommended NetSuite Model Context Protocol (“MCP”) Tool.
 - 2. Test and refine the AI prompts and instructions based on Your NetSuite configuration, customizations, and business objectives.
 - 3. Produce documentation or instructions for end users on how to test, assess against defined criteria, and share reusable AI prompts.
 - 4. During the ACS Period (defined in 3.Q below), update AI prompts pursuant to Your direction.
- P. Review data and AI output validation, adjust upstream data as agreed upon, and perform the following:

1. Review AI-generated output to verify it is consistent with how Your existing Oracle NetSuite instance is configured.
 2. Provide guidance on possible updates or changes to Your integrated NetSuite data modifications (e.g., saved searches, roles, reports).
- Q. *[NetSuite ACS Monitor only]*** You will receive up to 30 hours per year for module activation. Such module activation hours will be reset on the Start Date indicated in Your Estimate/Order Form and each anniversary of the Start Date thereafter (the “ACS Period”). Your module activation hours must be used within the ACS Period and will expire at the end of that ACS Period; any unused amounts are non-refundable and are forfeited at the end of such ACS Period.
- R. *[NetSuite ACS Monitor only]*** A standard list of modules that are available for activation will be presented to You at the time of activation.
- S.** Provide optimization and sustainment guidance and execution consisting of assistance with any of the following:
1. Making changes to Your business process flows.
 2. Oracle NetSuite SuiteCloud workflows, scripts, and integrations.
- T. *[NetSuite ACS Architect/NetSuite ACS Optimize only]*** Provide technical and functional systems architecture guidance that may consist of assisting You with any of the following:
1. Define the role of Oracle NetSuite products in a multi-vendor business solutions instance including master data management and data transaction architecture.
 2. Provide strategies to support, maintain and manage Your Oracle NetSuite instance to optimize development, testing and release activities.
 3. Work with You to help identify possible impacts of Oracle NetSuite products, Cloud Services, and product releases.
 4. Perform migration of changes between development, testing, and production instances.

4. Your Obligations and Assumptions

You acknowledge that Your timely provision of and access to assistance, cooperation, complete and accurate information and data from Your officers, agents, and employees (collectively, “cooperation”) are essential to the performance of any ACS Services as set forth in Your Estimate/Order Form. Oracle will not be responsible for any deficiency in performing ACS Services if such deficiency results from Your failure to provide full cooperation.

You acknowledge that Oracle’s ability to perform the ACS Services depends upon Your fulfillment of the following obligations and the following assumptions:

A. Your Obligations

1. Prior to the commencement of ACS Services, designate and identify a business resource that will be responsible for coordinating Your participation and provide on-going support for delivery of Your ACS Services for Your Oracle NetSuite instance.
 - a. You agree to designate one (1) primary contact and one (1) secondary contact who can provide Oracle with access to relevant functional, technical, and business resources with adequate skills and knowledge to support the performance of ACS Services.
 - b. You may authorize additional designated contacts, and You agree that any such contact will utilize review and support service hours.
2. Attend recurring status meetings that drive annual ACS Reviews and ongoing support.

3. Authorize Extended Service hours to be purchased if the hours required for Oracle to perform the ACS Review described in the Description of ACS Services above exceeds the total quantity of service hours allocated for the quarter as specified in Your Estimate/Order Form.
4. Provide User feedback during configuration and validation.
5. Be available as needed during the project to answer Oracle's questions, provide business decisions and other items as required.
6. Provide on-going support to Your Users following Oracle's completion of the Services.
7. Ensure Your existing procedure documentation and business procedure documentation is made available to Oracle prior to the commencement of the ACS Services.
8. Notify Oracle within five (5) business days about incomplete information in the documentation provided by Oracle to You.
9. Complete User Acceptance Testing and provide written confirmation to Oracle of completion of User Acceptance Testing, within a consecutive two (2) week period.
10. Identify, document, and raise issues that arise during User Acceptance Testing.
11. Resolve User Acceptance Testing issues assigned to You.
12. Obtain Cloud Services prior to the commencement of ACS Services under Your Estimate/Order Form and maintain such Cloud Services for the duration of the ACS Services provided under Your applicable Estimate/Order Form.
13. Maintain system updates and adhere to supported versions of the Oracle NetSuite instance.
14. Be responsible for post-production maintenance and support of the Oracle NetSuite instance.
15. Be responsible for any sandbox and/or development instances required by Oracle.
16. Be responsible for planning, executing, and managing all aspects of the system review, including preparing and executing test cases and plans, reviewing test results, and providing final User Acceptance Testing sign off.
17. Be responsible for validating requested changes in sandbox and validating those changes are migrated to production.
18. Be responsible for providing training to Users on the Cloud Service.
19. Be responsible for notifying Oracle if You elect to use ACS Services monthly support hours to provide guidance and recommendations on NetSuite Third Party Applications.
20. At Oracle's discretion, Oracle may assist You with Your review of Third Party Applications that may interact with the Cloud Service that is the subject of the ACS Services, provided, however, that You acknowledge and agree that (i) You must acquire any appropriate license rights necessary for Oracle to provide such assistance on Your behalf, (ii) You will independently obtain and review the product and other documentation published by the Third Party Application provider, (iii) Oracle has no specific knowledge about, expertise in, or experience with Third Party Application, and (iv) notwithstanding any statement or interpretation to the contrary, any such assistance provided by Oracle is provided without warranty of any kind.
21. Ensure the necessary digital licenses are acquired for any digital content that Oracle will use for the delivery of ACS Services upon Your request. This will include but is not limited to images, materials, and other content that Oracle will integrate into Your website.
22. Be responsible for any and all deficiencies or delays attributable to Your resources and/or Your third-party resources, and any resulting impact to the estimated timeline, work effort, and associated fees for services.
23. Provide Oracle with User access to Your systems necessary for the performance of ACS Services.
24. You shall not provide Oracle access to personal information.

25. Be responsible for providing any notices and obtaining any required consents necessary for performing the ACS Services, including but not limited to any notices and required consents for the processing or transfers of personal information.
26. Be responsible for removing ACS resource User access from Your systems once You have been notified by Oracle. Oracle will make reasonable efforts to notify You when an ACS Services resource is no longer designated to work on Your account.
27. Limit Oracle's access to any production instances or shared development instances to the extent necessary for Oracle to perform ACS Services.
28. Be responsible for managing, prioritizing, and communicating on ACS Services cases.
29. Be responsible for Your organizational change enablement and communication activities.
30. Use commercially reasonable efforts to attend all scheduled meetings. The repeated cancellation of meetings may result in delay and inefficient use of the maximum number of Service hours allowed for the performance of ACS Services.
31. Be responsible for providing Oracle with any requisite privacy and data security processing requirements as deemed necessary to comply with Your applicable legal and regulatory obligations.
32. Do not film or record Oracle's delivery of ACS Services, Oracle resources, or any Oracle materials. You may request sessions be recorded by Oracle on a case-by-case basis. Such recordings require advanced approval by Oracle.
33. Be responsible for any and all deficiencies or delays attributable to Your resources, including Your third-party resources, and any resulting impact to the estimated timeline, work effort, and associated fees for services.
34. *[NetSuite ACS Optimize/ NetSuite ACS Architect only]* Obtain NetSuite Premium Support under a separate contract prior to the commencement of ACS Optimize and ACS Architect Support Services under Your Estimate/Order Form and maintain such NetSuite Premium Support for the duration of the ACS Services provided under Your applicable Estimate/Order Form.

B. Additional Terms: Artificial Intelligence ("AI")

1. You are responsible for: (i) obtaining licenses for the BYO LLM (including as required for the NetSuite team to perform ACS Services) prior to the commencement of ACS Services related to the BYO LLM; (ii) integrating Your BYO LLM with Your NetSuite production instance; and (iii) ensuring that the NetSuite team performing ACS Services has the appropriate access to the BYO LLM on Your behalf. You acknowledge and agree the NetSuite team performing ACS Services shall be considered Your Users when accessing the NetSuite Cloud Service and the BYO LLM on Your behalf.
2. You are responsible for ensuring the BYO LLM is compatible with the NetSuite AI Connector Service.
3. You are responsible for reading, reviewing, and agreeing to any applicable third-party agreements and terms of use provided by the BYO LLM (the "BYO LLM Terms") prior to configuring a connection to Your instance of the NetSuite Cloud Service.
4. You will ensure that Your assigned personnel has the authority to accept the BYO LLM Terms on Your behalf, has the administrative rights to connect Your NetSuite production instance to the BYO LLM, and takes the necessary steps to connect the BYO LLM to Your NetSuite production instance.

5. You are responsible for Your and Your Users use of the BYO LLM and its output. You are responsible for ensuring You and Your Users comply with: (1) all acceptable use policies of the BYO LLM provider, including their BYO LLM Terms, and all updates thereto; (2) all laws and regulations applicable to Your use of the AI prompts, BYO LLM, and output; and (3) all of Your policies and procedures that govern the responsible use of Your confidential information, the AI prompts, and BYO LLM based upon Your standards.
6. You are solely responsible for ensuring You and Your Users: (1) are trained on how to use the AI prompts to meet Your business objectives; (2) are trained on the risks of external LLMs, and best practices for safe usage; and (3) review all AI prompts and output generated by the BYO LLM and independently verify the accuracy and appropriateness of the BYO LLM and output before its use.
7. You agree that the ACS Services will not involve, and You will not instruct Your Users or any third party (including the Oracle resources providing ACS Services) in relation to, the use of the AI prompts or BYO LLMs (or any other AI models or systems) in any manner that: (1) does not comply with applicable laws or (2) will, or will reasonably likely, be classified as 'high-risk' under applicable laws, unless otherwise agreed in writing between the Parties.
8. The BYO LLM is a Third Party Application under Your NetSuite Agreement that governs Your NetSuite Cloud Services. You are responsible for accepting and complying with the BYO LLM provider's terms of access and use of the BYO LLM. AS BETWEEN YOU AND ORACLE, THE BYO LLM, THE AI PROMPTS, AND OUTPUT ARE PROVIDED ON AN "AS IS" AND "AS AVAILABLE" BASIS, AND ORACLE DISCLAIMS ALL WARRANTIES, INDEMNITIES, AND LIABILITIES ARISING FROM OR RELATED TO THE BYO LLM, THE AI PROMPTS, AND OUTPUT.
9. You must separately purchase from Oracle (if the BYO LLM is Oracle's Generative AI Service) or the third-party BYO LLM provider the necessary quantity of tokens to enable Your use of the AI prompts.

C. Assumptions

1. Oracle will solely determine if any ACS Services involving configuration, development and/or testing should be conducted in a sandbox/development instance prior to being applied to a production instance.
2. Oracle reserves the right to object to and decline a service request if Oracle believes, in its sole determination, that completion of such service request may result in potentially unfavorable outcome(s) to Your system or if the service request is outside of the scope of ACS Services.
3. All project documentation, presentations and project communications are in English, or such other available languages the parties may agree upon in writing.
4. You do not require consultants to work outside standard local country workday hours unless mutually agreed to in advance to support onsite activities.
5. Your primary form of communication with Oracle outside of meetings described as a part of the ACS Services described in Section A (Description of ACS Services) above will be by email and the Oracle NetSuite case management tool.
6. All ACS Services will be performed remotely; however, at Your request, and at Oracle's sole discretion, Oracle may agree to conduct an onsite visit(s) to provide ACS Services during the Professional Services Term. You agree to be responsible for any travel and out-of-pocket expenses incurred by Oracle related to providing any ACS Services onsite.

7. When services are performed onsite at a customer location in the US, and as required by U.S. Department of Labor regulations (20 CFR 655.734), You will allow Oracle to post a Notice regarding Oracle H-1B employee(s) at the work site prior to the employee's arrival onsite.
8. A minimum of one Oracle resource will provide overall coordination, management, and execution to You.
9. Oracle has sole discretion in determining if the project meets the ACS required tasks limits, including the amount of time it takes an ACS resource to complete a project.
10. Oracle resources are not dedicated to any single project and are engaged across many projects for various customers; Oracle resource assignment is at Oracle's sole discretion.
11. Oracle is not responsible for any configuration, updates, development and/or testing on Third Party Applications.
12. Access to Your Oracle NetSuite instance will only be through Oracle login credentials specifically assigned to an ACS resource.
13. *[NetSuite ACS Monitor only]* Service hours will be prorated for any partial quarters.

5. Unused ACS hours

The maximum number of allowable ACS hours (including any Extended Service hours) identified in Your Estimate/Order Form must be used by You in the identified amount of time specified in Your Estimate/Order Form. Any portion of the ACS hours unused will be automatically forfeited by You with no further action required of either party. You will not be entitled to a refund, or any credit toward additional or other services.

During the Term of Your Estimate/Order Form, if You need to add hours throughout the remainder of Your contract Term, You can purchase Extended Service hours. 4. Limit Oracle’s access to any production instances or shared development instances to the extent necessary for Oracle to perform Support Services.
5. Use commercially reasonable efforts to undertake product enablement prior to engaging Support Services for any specific Oracle NetSuite Cloud Service, where such enablement is available.
6. As required by U.S. Department of Labor regulations (20 CFR 655.734), You will allow Oracle to post a Notice regarding Oracle H-1B employee(s) at the work site prior to the employee's arrival on site.
7. Be responsible for any sandbox and/or development instances required by Oracle.
8. Be responsible for UAT.
9. Be responsible for Your organizational change enablement and communication activities.
10. Do not film or record Oracle’s delivery of Support Services, Oracle resources, or any Oracle materials.
11. Use commercially reasonable efforts to attend all scheduled meetings. The repeated cancellation of meetings may result in delay and inefficient use of the maximum number of Service hours per quarter allowed for the performance of Support Services.
12. Provide Oracle with view only access to Your customer’s systems necessary for the performance of Support Services.
13. Procure, if required, a Google Analytics account and provide Oracle with authorized view only access to Your customers’ Google Analytics account.

B. Project Assumptions

1. Oracle reserves the right to object to and decline a service request if Oracle believes, in its sole determination, that completion of such service request may result in potentially unfavorable outcome(s) to Your system, or if the service request is outside of the scope of Support Services.
2. All Support Services are performed remotely.
3. All Support Services communication are in English.
4. You do not require Oracle consultants to work outside standard local country workday hours.
5. The Support Services described above will be limited to supported browsers. Oracle’s updated published list of supported browsers can be found on SuiteAnswers within Your Oracle NetSuite

Cloud Service instance by searching for “supported browsers” in the search tool and clicking on the resulting document. Notwithstanding the foregoing, Oracle may in its sole discretion de-support or refuse to perform Support Services on any supported web browsers or mobile device operating system that it believes to be vulnerable or otherwise lacks adequate security and will inform You as early as possible of such decision.

6. Oracle resources cannot execute, deploy code, or otherwise make changes to Your data within Your customers’ Oracle NetSuite Cloud Services.
7. Your primary form of communication with Oracle outside of meetings described as a part of the Support Services described in section 1 (Description of Support Services) above will be by email and the Oracle NetSuite case management tool.

3. Unused Support Services

The maximum number of allowable Service hours per quarter (including any Extended Hours purchased for such quarter) identified in Your order must be used by You in that quarter. Any portion of the Support Services unused in such quarter will be automatically forfeited by You in that quarter, with no further action required of either party, and You will not be entitled to a refund, or any credit toward additional or other services, for any unused portion of the fees paid for any unused Service hours in that quarter for the Support Services. For Oracle to provide Support Services set out in the above Description of Support Services after the Term of Your order, Oracle and You must mutually agree upon a separate order for such Support Services.

If the last quarter of the Term of Your order is less than three (3) months, then the quarterly Service hours will be pro-rated accordingly.

4. Extended Hours

During the Term of Your order, the parties may mutually agree in writing to increase the quantity of Service hours per quarter indicated in Your order for any given quarter. Oracle will invoice You for any such Extended Hours at the Extended Hourly Rate set out in Your order.

5. Primary Point of Contact

You agree to designate a primary contact who will work together with Oracle to facilitate an efficient delivery of Support Services. Additional designated contacts authorized by You may contact Oracle, and You agree that any such contact will utilize Service hours.
