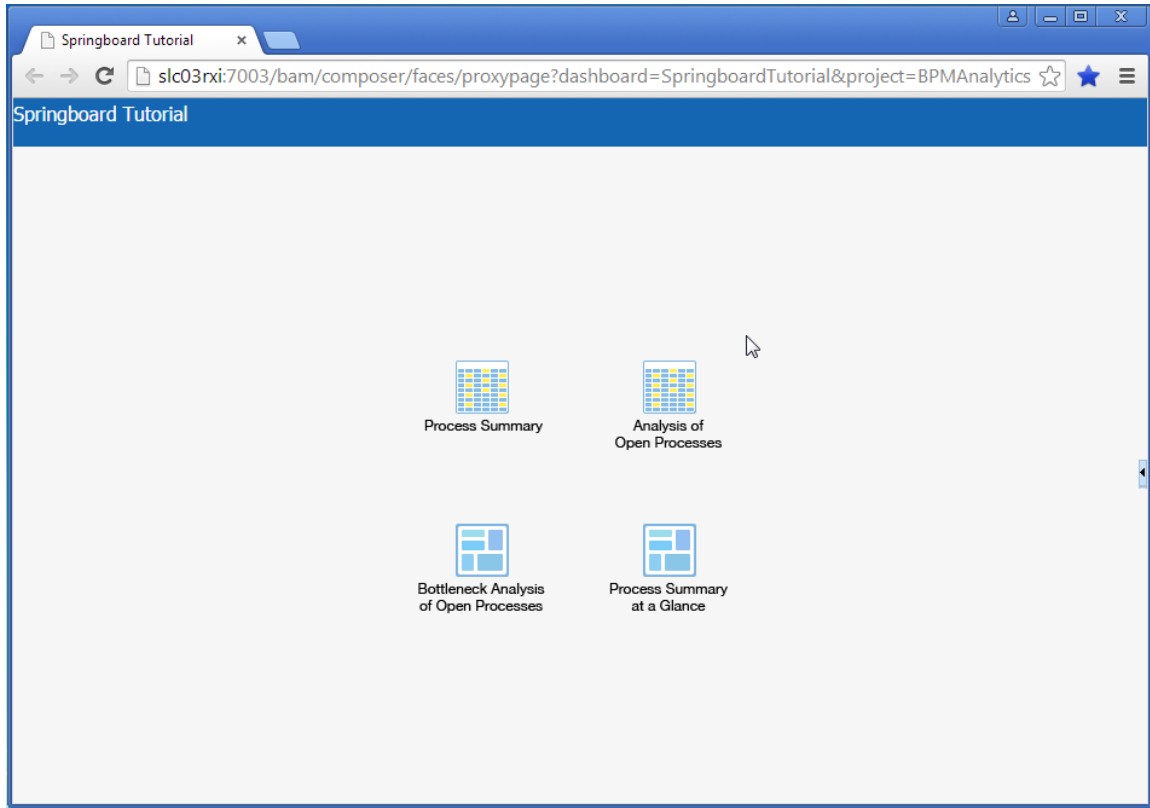

Objectives:

This hands-on lab will show you how to create a dashboard landing page with icons. Clicking on icons will open new tabs with different dashboards.



Tutorial Steps:

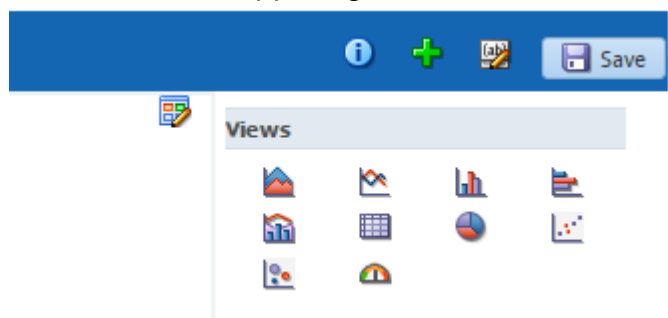
- 1) Login to BAM Composer
- 2) Open a project that has existing dashboards
- 3) Create a new dashboard by clicking on "Dashboards" in the project navigation tree. Select an empty style template "Type-1".

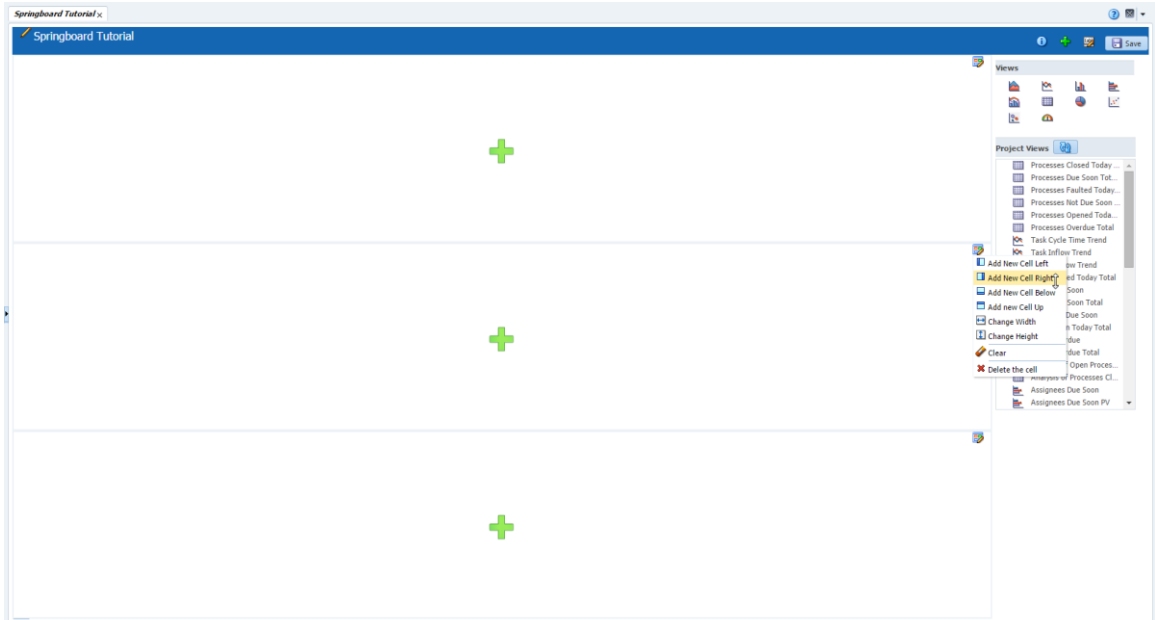

- 4) Create a grid pattern of views as show below.
 - a) Click “+” icon in upper right to add two more rows.

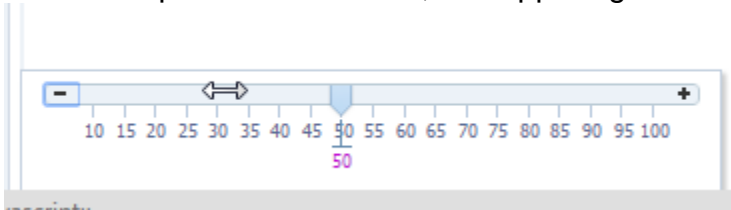

- b) In middle row, click upper right icon to “Add New Cell Right”. Do this twice.



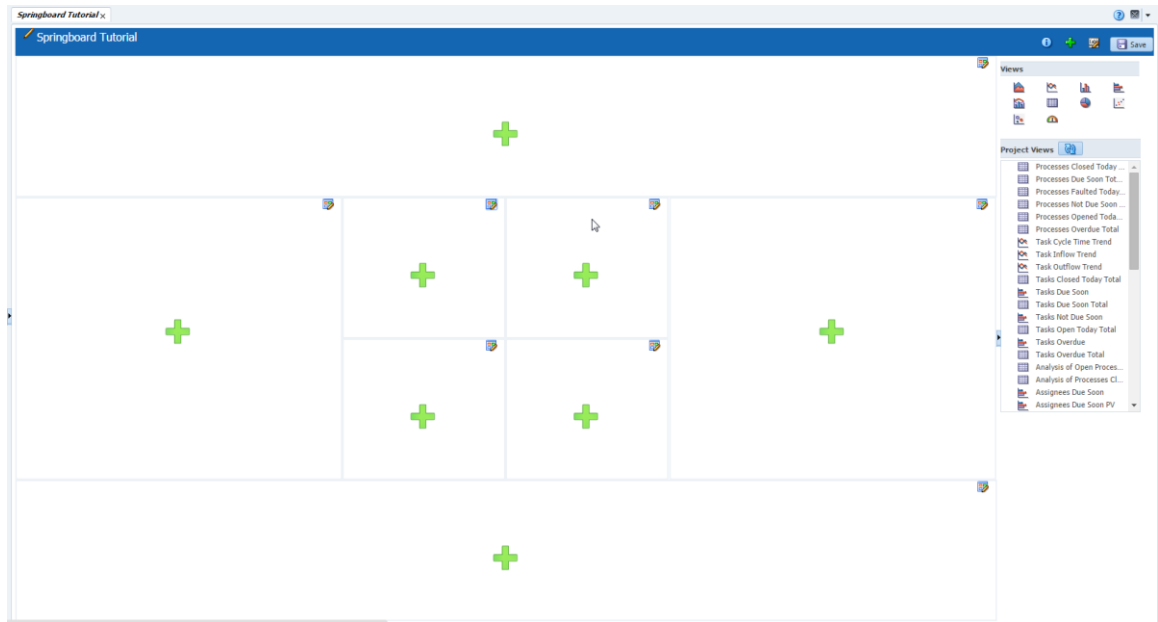
- c) For both top and bottom rows, use upper right icon to set heights to 25%.



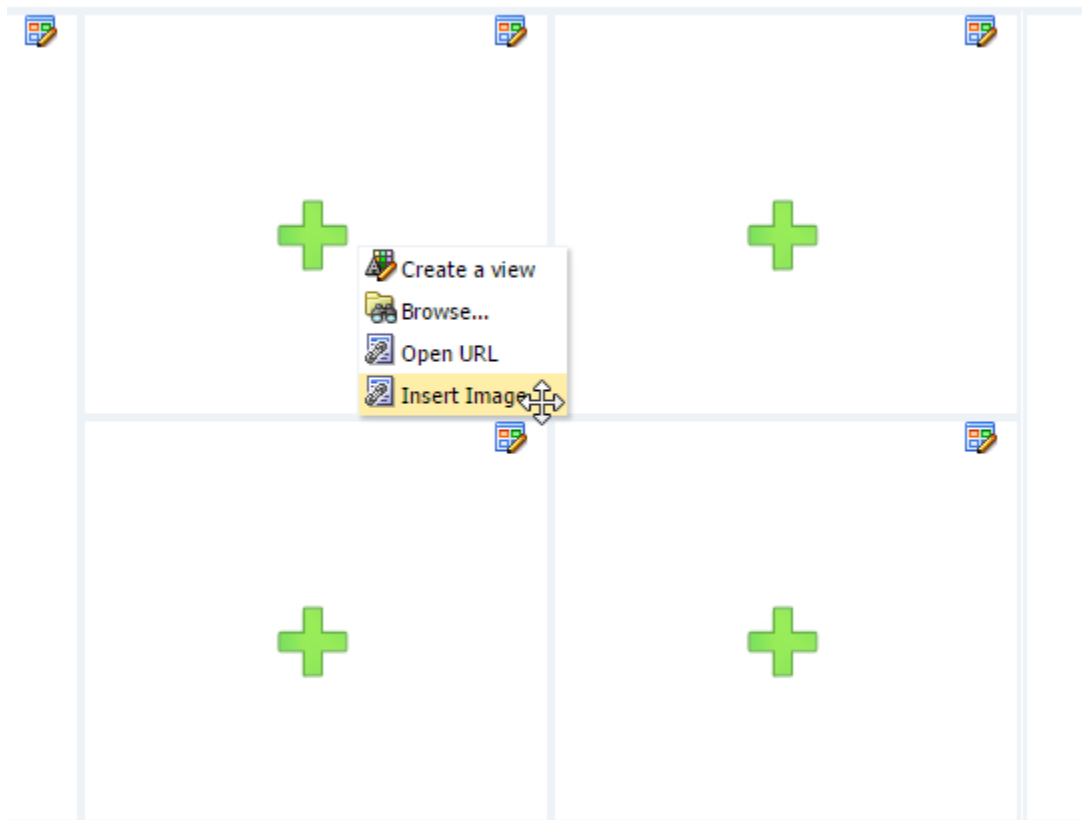
- d) In the center view, use upper right icon to “Add New Cell Below”, and then in the newly created two small rows, do “Add New Cell Right”. See final

result below.

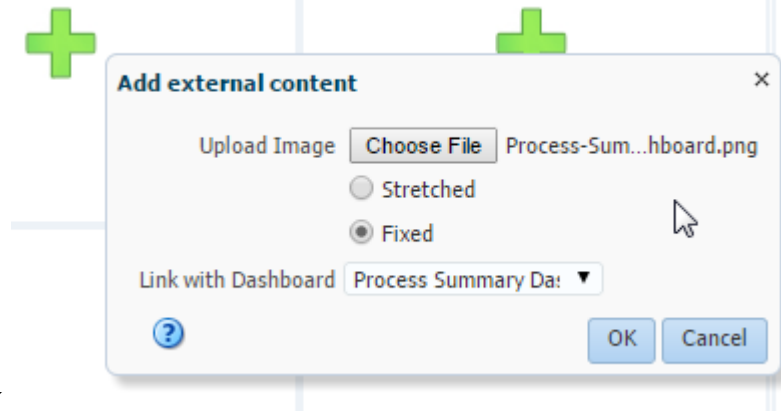


- 5) In the upper left of the four middle views, click the green plus icon and select "Insert Image".



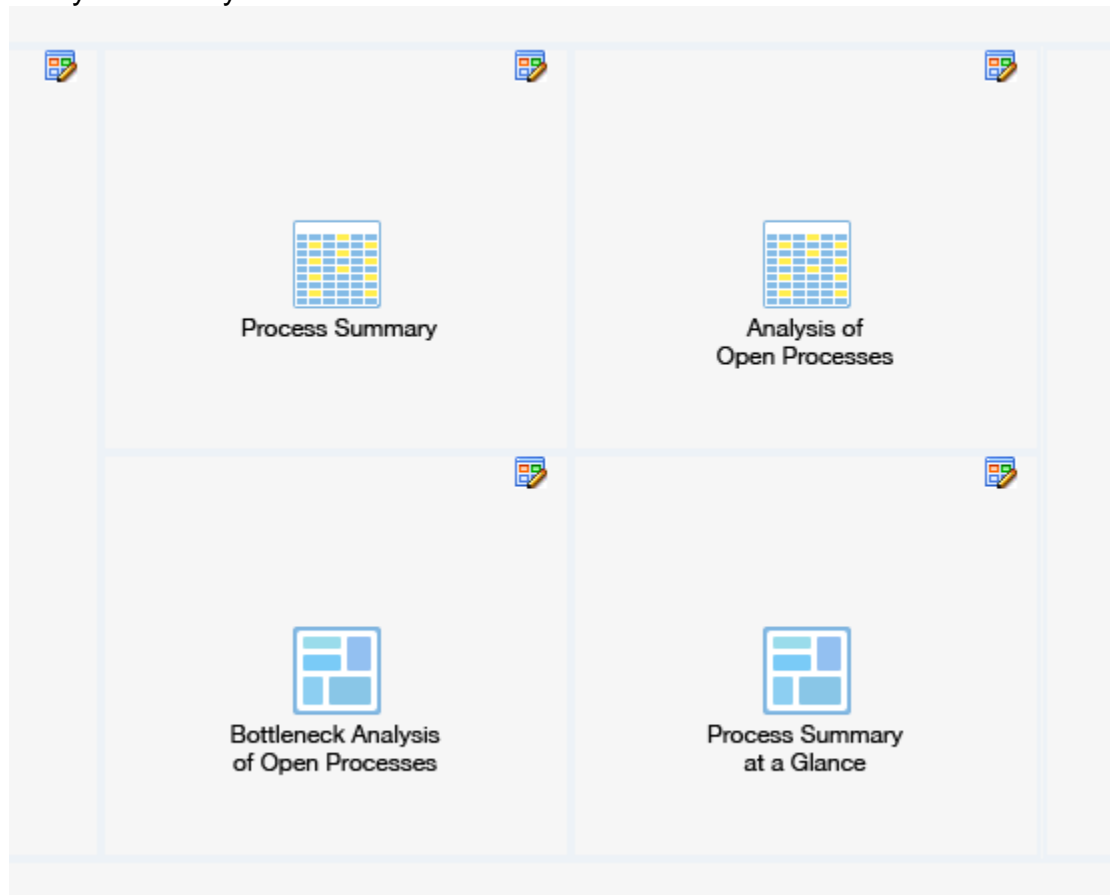

- 6) Select icon file location and the target dashboard. Clicking “Fixed” will display Icon without any stretching – choose according to your preference.



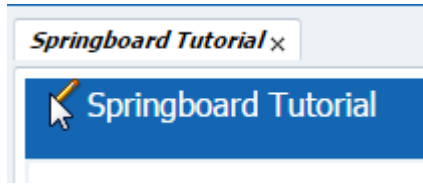
Click OK.

- 7) Icon is now shown in Dashboard preview. Repeat steps ‘h’ and ‘i’ for as many icons as you would like.

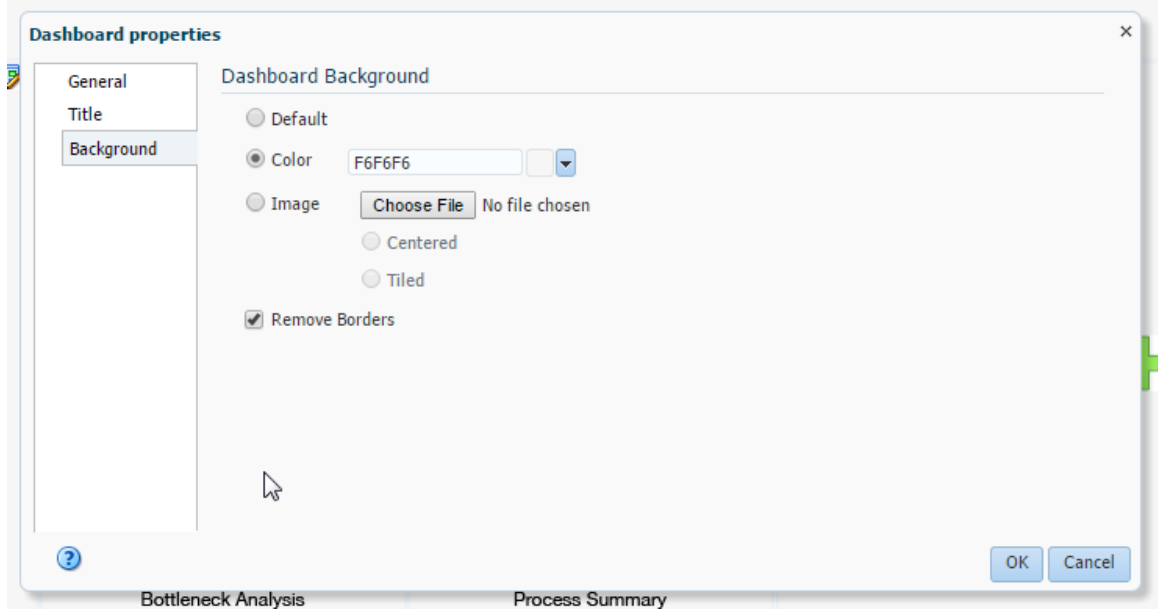


- 8) Click edit icon in upper left, and open “Background” section.

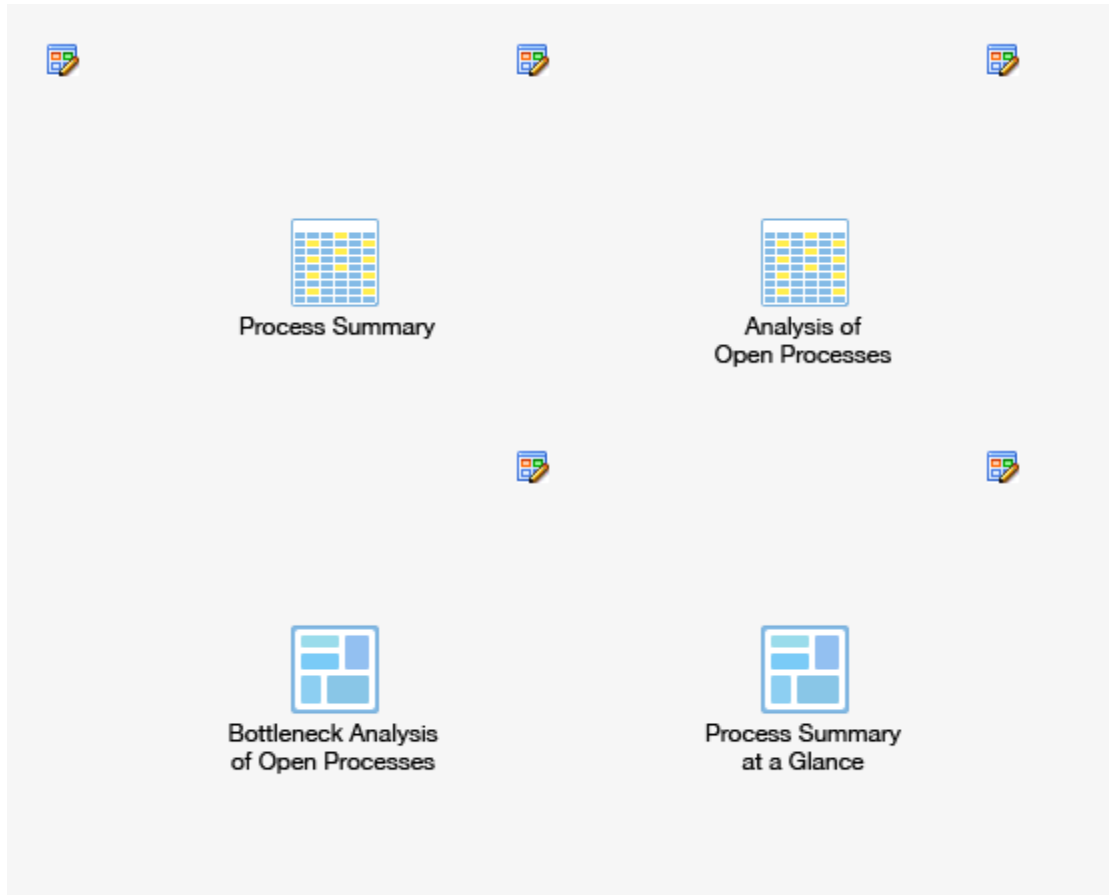


9) Choose a background color (e.g. #F6F6F6) and select "Remove Borders".



10) Dashboard preview now looks like:

11) Click Save, and open the Springboard Tutorial dashboard. Clicking on an icon will open its corresponding target dashboard.
