1. The Apache 1.3 plugin delivered with UCM is not compatible with some Apache modules that change the content of the delivered page. Upgrading to Apache 2 would bypass this limitation. Apache 1.3 cannot handle files over 2 Gigabytes in size thus it might not be good fit for Digital Asset Management (DAM) modules.
2. There are some known issues with IBM HTTP Server 6.x due to which configuration changes are required for proper functionality with UCM. IBM HTTP Server should be run as single thread per process. Set ThreadPerChild=1 in httpd.conf of IBM HTTP Server. IBM HTTP Server can also be recompiled from source with worker MPM to allow the web server to run in multi-threaded mode.
