Oracle Hyperion Financial Data Quality Management Enterprise Edition application shifts data management responsibility from the IT department to the finance team. This means the design, configuration, and maintenance of mapping rules and validations fall squarely within the domain of finance. This is a key factor in realizing successful financial management because the complexity of data relationships requires deep accounting and finance expertise during the financial close process. In the meantime, the IT department is relieved of supporting intricate interfaces more easily maintained by the finance community.

Extensive support for XBRL

Another module in Oracle's Financial Close and Reporting suite, Oracle Hyperion Disclosure Management, enables creation and validation of XBRL reports for debt management, grants management or any other type of Financial-based government reporting. XBRL improves the efficiency, accuracy and transparency of reporting and information exchange. The key to the power of XBRL is the concept of a taxonomy, or metadata model. The taxonomy not only tags the data but also defines structure to the information being exchanged, business rules that operate on the information, and a framework for easily creating new taxonomies by extending existing ones.
